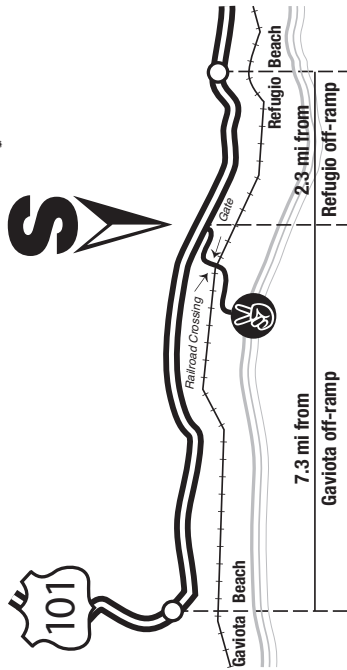


WHERE'S THE SECRET SEASIDE HIDAWAY

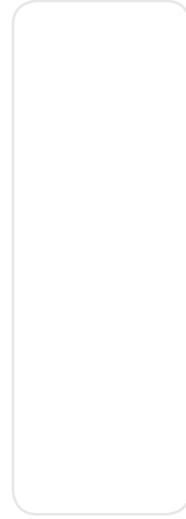
Down from the north: south on Highway 101, turn right exactly 7.3 miles past Gaviota State Beach onto the frontage road.

From the south: north on Highway 101, turn left exactly 2.3 miles past Refugio Road, cross southbound 101 onto the frontage road.

Here the frontage road heads to the right (west) about 150 yards, then turns toward the ocean and crosses railroad tracks, continuing west to Playa Quemada. There are no signals or warnings at the railroad crossing, so STOP, Look, Listen, and cross carefully.



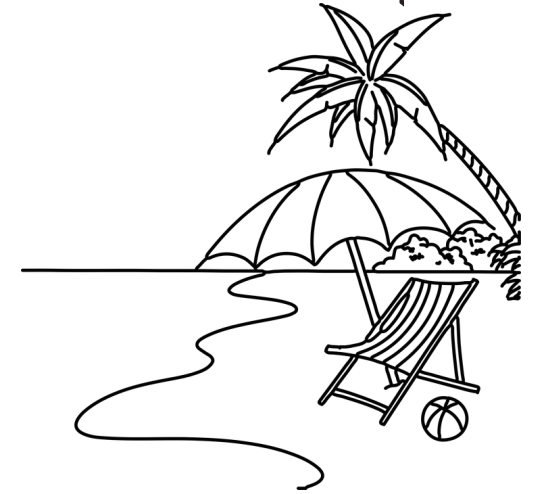
